-Newton Institutional Links call for proposals

Newton Institutional Links are grants for the development of research and innovation collaborations between the UK and partner country institutions at the group, departmental or institutional level, as well as the commercial and not-for-profit sector.

Grants will be £30,000 to £300,000 over two years (depending on the country) and will cover collaborations between the UK and partner country.

The following countries are included in this call: Brazil, Colombia, Egypt, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Mexico, Philippines, Vietnam.

- Clear focus and possible application in Egypt
- Scientific soundness

Re-invitation Program for Former Scholarship Holders (WE)

The Re-invitation Program helps the DAAD maintain contacts with its former scholarship holders (DAAD Alumni) who had studied in Germany for at least on year. DAAD Alumni can apply for an invitation to Germany with the purpose of completing a research or work project at a state higher education institution or non-university research institute. The stays range from 1 to 3 months and cannot be extended.

Target group of the WE program are PhD holders working at Egyptian universities or research institutions.

Former scholarship holders of the programs "Public Policy and Good Governance" and "Development-Related Postgraduate Courses" are also eligible to apply.

Academic Excellence Scholarships (AES) for International Students in Australia, 2015

La Trobe University is offering academic excellence scholarships (AES) for pursuing undergraduate and postgraduate coursework programs.

Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than Australia or New Zealand and be applying to start an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework program. They must also have scored 85% or equivalent in their previous degree/award, and meet English language and academic entry requirements. Scholarships are worth between \$10,000 and \$20,000 and are paid across a maximum of two semesters (or 12 months).

The application deadlines are 5 December 2014 and 18 January 2015.
