





Egypt-Russia Cooperation Program for Scientific Research

The Russian Foundation for Basic Research (RFBR) and the Egyptian Science and Technology Development Fund (STDF) agreed to co-finance collaborative research projects.

Projects are conducted under the direction of an Egyptian and Russian Principal Investigator (PI) and therefore, *must* have partner institutions from Egypt and Russia. Apart from being the Principal Investigators, each PI is responsible for coordinating the activities of the research project and his/her research team and is responsible for the submission of progress reports. Work on joint projects may be performed at institutions in either or both countries, depending on the type of activity

The Egyptian and Russian sides, STDF and RFBR, respectively, identified the topics for their mutual cooperation and they agreed on the following areas:

- Mathematics
- Material Science
- Fundamental Problems in Nuclear Science
- Fundamental Problems in Mechatronics
- Fundamentals of Cancer Diagnosis and Therapy

Alexander von Humboldt Foundation's Sofja Kovalevskaja Award in Germany, 2015

Federal Ministry of Education and Research is awarding Sofja Kovalevskaja Award for Scientists and scholars from all countries and disciplines who completed their doctorates with distinction less than six years ago. The Foundation particularly welcomes applications from qualified, female junior researchers. This international award is granted to young exceptionally promising researchers from abroad to enable them to embark on academic careers in Germany by establishing their own junior research groups at research institutions in Germany. The Humboldt Foundation plans to grant up to eight Sofja Kovalevskaja Awards. The award is valued at up to 1.65 million EUR. The application deadline is September 1, 2014.
