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Effect Quality of Working Life on Managerial Skills among Academic Staff

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ABSTRACT

The study aims to identify effect Quality of working life on managerial skills among Academic staff.

This study was conducted on a accidental sample of 100 academic staff from Agriculture Faculty in Alexandria University. The data were collected by using a questionnaire through personal interview. The data were analyzed statistically using (SPSS) were percentages, median, standard deviation, simple correlation coefficient and multiple regression function. The study revealed that :-

- High level from Quality working life of participants were low, reaching 17%
- High level from managerial skills of participants were low, reaching 16%
- There were statistically a positive significant correlation between managerial skills level's and Quality working life level's at probability of 0.01 and years number of marriage, income, degree of job at probability of 0.05.
- The results showed that Quality working life level's was the most variables Affecting the level of managerial skills reaching 10.3%
